Cotroceni Museum – the place of Presidential Administration



Romanian Peasant Museum – built up between 1912 and 1938; the style of this ensemble collocates traditional elements of Moldavian and Țara Românească feudal architecture.



Patriarchal Cathedral – the ensemble was initiated under the reign of Șerban Basarab in 1655 and finished in 1698 under the reign of Constantin Brancoveanu. The building is impressive: 28 m length internal yard, with a 14,6 m nave, this location is important for all official religious ceremonies. Here was attained, in 1688, Bucharest Bible, the first complete translation in Romanian, highly valuable paper work, with importance in the progress of Romanian language.

The Triumph Archer – first time was built in 1896 in wood in the honour of the marriage between Prince Ferdinand and future Queen Mary; in 1922 was reconstructed in stone, in the memory of Romanian Army victory in First World War and finished in present form in 1935.
